### RECREATION

#### (Town Walk Trails)

**Bi-centennial Walk Trail** (6km round trip) through bush reserves ( wildflowers in season), along the Blackwood River and the Boyup Brook, where you can detour (behind the old Railway Station) into the Boyup Brook Billabong. There are several entry / exit points and 7 sitting-logs along the way for R&R; 100yr old concrete 'railway' dam and 390m of unique 'swale' drains.

**Bridle Trail** (5km return) from the old railway station along the Boyup Brook to 'Skeleton' Bridge, picnic at the gazebo on the Blackwood River.

**Kura Kartaga Langa Trail** (2km return) from the **Boyup Brook Billabong** (behind the Railway Station) to Jayes Rd is an optional detour from the main 'Bicentennial' walk track to be able to rejoin it at Jayes Road.

**Heritage Trail** (Heritage Trail) plinths mark the sites of original business premises.

**Swimming Pool** 25m with diving pool (3m high-board and 1m spring-board); covered paddle pool. Open air, grassed & shaded picnic grounds. Sand sculpture.

## β (Places to Visit IN/OUT of Town)

**Boyup Brook Visitor Centre** The oldest standing public building in the town & 2nd  
oldest in the Shire (1910) then known as the Agricultural Hall. Stone/brick/iron

**Dinninup Hall 1** ➡ 'The Brick Hall' Oldest standing public building in the Shire (1905).  
Brick/iron. Found at Show Grounds

**Dinninup Hall 2** ➡ 'The Large Hall' built 1919 - timber/iron. At Show Grounds.

**Flaxmill** The Flax Mill site is significant for the production of ropes and webbing from  
flax grown in the district during World War II. Of all of the Flax mills established through  
out Australia it is the only one partly still standing.

**Norlup** ➡ ☎ 9767 3034 Lance/Margaret First convict-built home - restored.

**Gregory Tree** ➡ β (The Gregory Tree) Bears the Bench Mark of 'A G' over  
'184?' by colonial surveyor and explorer A C Gregory.

**Railway Station Buildings** mostly weather-board, Barracks; working crane.
